Directions to Meeting:

From Downtown via 110/Pasadena Freeway: Exit Orange Grove Boulevard. Turn left on Orange Grove Boulevard to Rosemont Avenue. Turn left on to Rosemont Avenue and proceed down the hill. Pass the Rose Bowl and the Brookside Country Club will be on your left.

From San Fernando Valley via 210/Foothill Freeway: Exit Arroyo/Windsor off ramp and turn right onto Arroyo. Make another immediate right turn onto Rosemont Avenue and proceed down the hill. Brookside Country Club will be on your right.

From San Fernando Valley via 134/Ventura Freeway: Exit Orange Grove/Colorado Boulevard off ramp. Turn left on Orange Grove Boulevard to Rosemont Avenue. Turn left onto Rosemont and proceed down the hill. Pass the Rose Bowl and the Brookside Country Club will be on your left.

From San Gabriel Valley via 210/Foothill Freeway: Exit Seco/Mountain off ramp. Turn left on Seco Street and proceed down the hill to Rosemont Avenue. Turn right onto Rosemont. Pass the Rose Bowl and the Brookside Country Club will be on your left.

Dinner: Dinner will be provided for Conservancy and Advisory Committee members at 6:00 p.m. at the Brookside Country Club.

Note-Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy Meeting: The regular meeting for the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy will convene at 8:00p.m. at the Brookside Country Club in Pasadena. Please refer to the separate agenda enclosed for further details.

Note: The period between 7:15 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. has been set aside for public testimony. No public testimony will be taken after 7:30 p.m. The public hearing begins at 7:15 p.m. In the event that all speakers have been heard prior to 7:30 p.m., or upon completion of public hearing, whichever occurs first, the public hearing and comment period will be closed and the Conservancy and Advisory Committee deliberations will begin. Individuals will be allowed three minutes to speak and representatives of organizations/agencies will be allowed 5 minutes to speak. Speaker times may be reduced depending on the number of speakers.

5. Consideration of resolution adopting a Memorandum of Understanding with the San Gabriel and Lower Los Angeles River and Mountains Conservancy.
6. Consideration of resolution of intent to adopt the applicable portions of San Gabriel and Los Angeles Rivers Watershed and Open Space Plan as an amendment to the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan and Rim of the Valley Trail Corridor Master Plan and forwarding such plan to local government jurisdictions pursuant to Public Resources Code Sections 33204.3 and 33210.
7. Announcement of future meetings and adjournment.

Note: Written communications received by close of business on the Thursday prior to the meeting will be duplicated and distributed to each member. Information on agenda items will be available for review on the Friday prior to the meeting at the following locations: Los Angeles River Center and Gardens, Brentwood Public Library, Calabasas Public Library, Encino/Tarzana Public Library, Malibu Public Library, North Hollywood Public Library, Sylmar Public Library, and the Thousand Oaks Public Library. The Conservancy may hold a closed session on any public hearing item pursuant to Section 11126 Subdivision (c)(7)(A), Section 11126.3(a) and Section 11126 Subdivision (e) of the Government Code.
