



Dear Board Member,

I am writing to convey our opposition, in the strongest possible terms, to the north access road to the Diemer Plant proposed by Metropolitan Water District (MWD). As you may know, this is an effort to divert MWD traffic off of streets in Yorba Linda and into Brea. Over the last ten years there were several opportunities for MWD to negotiate this road without impacting Chino Hills State Park. In the process of approving the Shell-Aera project (Vista Del Verde), the City of Yorba Linda did not require any mitigation for the MWD trucks to soften the impact through residential streets. Additional traffic on Brea streets and into the primary Orange County entrance of the State Park should not be the solution to the poor planning by other jurisdictions.

The continuing abuse of State Park land by jurisdictions unable or unwilling to plan proper infrastructure elsewhere should not be allowed in Chino Hills State Park, a state park already suffering from urban impacts, habitat fragmentation and edge effects.
