 Fee acquisition of 18.2 acres adjacent to Lindero Creek in the City of Agoura Hills, and related closing costs. APN 2056-001-900 (Portion).

Funding Source Applied for: Proposition 50

Narrative/Project Description:
 Lindero Creek Open Space consists of 18.2 acres of undeveloped land located at the north end of Reyes Adobe Road and east of Lindero Canyon Road in the City of Agoura Hills. Surrounding the project site are residential and commercial areas. The open space for the project is currently owned by a willing seller, the Las Virgenes Unified School District.

The purpose of the grant is to help purchase the land. Once the land is purchased, the site would be developed in a park, which would include a Fitness and Nature Trail and a parking area. The Fitness and Nature Trail would run from the south end of the park to the north end and continue north into the Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District. The Trail would provide youth and the general public with active recreation in an outdoor environment. Comprised of a carefully-ordered series of exercise stations along a loop trail, the Fitness and Nature Trail would allow for health and fitness benefit among its participants. Moreover, the Trail would respond to the concern for obesity and overweight problems among youth and the general public by providing an alternative recreational resource for the physically inactive. Finally, the location of the trail is ideal; undeveloped open space provides for a comfortable exercise environment away from road hazards, noise, and exhaust pollution.

The project site would be made easily accessible to the public. An access road beginning at the north end of Reyes Adobe Road will continue north into the open space and allow for access to the Fitness and Nature Trail. A parking area will be located just south of the Fitness and Nature Trail.
