**Brief Scope of Work** (60 words maximum):  
 Capital improvements to Franklin Canyon Park's visitor-serving amenities including the Sooky Goldman Nature Center Courtyard, Eugene and Michael Rosenfeld Auditorium, Sam Goldman Amphitheater, Doheny Ranch Picnic Area, Upper Picnic Area, Heavenly Pond Picnic Area, and park restrooms and fencing.

**Funding Source Applied for:** Proposition 40

**Narrative/Project Description:**  
 Established in 1981, Franklin Canyon Park offers numerous visitor-serving amenities in a natural woodland setting. While all of the facilities are functional, a few select improvements to the park's capital assets will make the park into a prime destination. The MRCA is proposing minor renovations to the Sooky Goldman Nature Center Courtyard, the Sam Goldman Amphitheater, the Doheny Ranch Picnic Area, Upper Picnic Area, Heavenly Pond Picnic Area, and restrooms and fencing throughout the park. More comprehensive capital improvements are proposed for the Eugene and Michael Rosenfeld Auditorium.

A discussion of the proposed improvements for each area follows:

Eugene and Michael Rosenfeld Auditorium  
 New roof, new HVAC system, replacement of interior finishes, upgrades to lighting and ceiling tiles.

Sooky Goldman Nature Center Courtyard  
 Irrigation upgrades, new backflow preventer, new landscaping and mulch, upgrade pathways, new drinking fountain.
