

Subject: **Agenda Item 18: Consideration of resolution adopting a project plan for Temescal Canyon, Pacific Palisades.**

Staff Recommendation: That the Conservancy adopt the attached resolution recommending adopting a project plan for Temescal Canyon, Pacific Palisades.

Legislative Authority: Section 33209 of the Public Resources Code provides, in part, as follows:

Every project submitted for funding pursuant to section 33208 shall have an adopted project plan...

Background: The Conservancy used a grant from the 1992 Los Angeles County Safe Neighborhood Parks Act (Proposition A) to acquire and develop 141 acres of property in Temescal Canyon. The acquisition did not involve state funding and a project plan was not adopted at the time of the acquisition. In 2007 the Conservancy granted Proposition 84 funds to the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) for improvements to Temescal Canyon. The proposed action would adopt a project plan for the activities funded by the Proposition 84 grant and those proposed in Item 17.
