

Subject: **Agenda Item 12: Consideration of resolution adopting a project plan for Vista Hermosa Park, Los Angeles.**

Staff Recommendation: That the Conservancy adopt the attached resolution recommending adopting a project plan for Vista Hermosa Park, Los Angeles.

Legislative Authority: Section 33209 of the Public Resources Code provides, in part, as follows:

Every project submitted for funding pursuant to section 33208 shall have an adopted project plan...

Background: At the June 23, 2003 board meeting, the Conservancy approved a grant of Proposition 12 funds to the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority for the Project Planning & Design for the Vista Hermosa Park Project, Los Angeles. A draft Project Plan for this Project was submitted for the September 22, 2003 Conservancy meeting. However, the item was not adopted. The Conservancy subsequently approved grants of Proposition 50 and Proposition 84 funds to the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority for the project.

Vista Hermosa Park was opened to the public on July 19, 2008. The proposed action would adopt a project plan for the activities funded by the Proposition 12, 50 and 84 grants.
