As you may know, on Tuesday, June 24, 1997, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to delete all references to Towsley Canyon from the Countywide Siting Element. With this action, Towsley Canyon was dropped from further consideration as a future landfill site and, for the first time in more than a decade, is no longer considered a candidate for that use by Los Angeles County.

On behalf of the City Council and citizens of Santa Clarita, I would like to extend our thanks and appreciation for the effort you and Paul put forth to assist us in providing critical information to the Board. We believe that, in no small part, the information provided was effective in persuading County staff to reconsider its long-held position that Towsley Canyon was a suitable and viable landfill. Additionally, your letter of June 23, 1997, to Supervisor Antonovich was also timely and of tremendous value.

Over the past few years, the City and the Conservancy have enjoyed a close, productive, and successful partnership dedicated to preserving parkland for future generations to enjoy. In closing, let me again thank you and Paul for your help in achieving this most recent success.
