RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY
ADOPTING ELEPHANT HILL, MONTEREY HILLS, SOUTH PASADENA
BASELINE WILDLIFE CORRIDOR MAP

WHEREAS, the subject Elephant Hills, Monterey Hills, South Pasadena Baseline Wildlife Corridor Map contain key habitat and wildlife corridor connections in northeast Los Angeles and South Pasadena; and

WHEREAS, the staff report dated January 27, 2014 further describes the project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is consistent with the *Rim of the Valley Trail Corridor Master Plan*; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Now

Therefore Be It Resolved, That the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy hereby:

1. FINDS the proposed action is consistent with the *Rim of the Valley Trail Corridor Master Plan*.
2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated January 27, 2014.
4. ADOPTS the Elephant Hills, Monterey Hills, South Pasadena Baseline Wildlife Corridor Map dated January 27, 2014.
5. AUTHORIZES the Chairperson to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution.
