Project Objective: The project proposes to add amenities to approx. 2.7 acres of undeveloped land near Escondido Canyon Park. The land was acquired in late 2017 and contains high-value ecological resources as well as a key trail linkage for the Coastal Slope Trail, and a previously proposed local connector trail. A previously graded and disturbed pad provides an opportunity for amenities while still maintaining an appropriate buffer to the creek. Accessible parking, picnic tables, trails, and other amenities would be provided. Any significant development at the site would require an application for a coastal development permit (CDP) with significant investments for engineering, geotechnical studies, biological surveys, and other analysis of the impact of proposed improvements. *Attach additional pages as necessary



**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE MOUNTAINS RECREATION
AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO
THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY FOR PROPOSITION 84
FUNDS FOR THE VIA ESCONDIDO ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS**

Resolved, That the Governing Board of the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) hereby:

1. FINDS that Via Escondido Access Improvements will provide significant public benefits;
2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act;
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendations dated February 7, 2018;
4. AUTHORIZES the grant application to the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy for Proposition 84 funds for the Via Escondido Public Access Improvements in the amount of \$250,000;
5. AUTHORIZES any budget amendments as necessary;
6. AUTHORIZES the Executive Officer or his designee to do any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution and any recommendations made by the Governing Board; and
7. AUTHORIZES the Chair to sign the grant agreement if the grant application is approved by the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy.
