RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY ADDING THE SAGE RANCH
PARK ADDITIONS AND COLD CREEK-RED ROCK CONNECTOR PROJECTS TO
PROPOSITION A (SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS ACT OF 1996)
WORKPROGRAM

WHEREAS, Land acquisition in the Sage Ranch-Dayton Canyon area and Cold Creek-Red Rock watershed divide area are important to the overall integrity of the Santa Monica Mountains Zone; now

Therefore Be It Resolved, That the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy hereby:

1. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
2. FINDS that the proposed action is consistent with the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan and the Rim of the Valley Trail Corridor Master Plan.
3. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated February 26, 2007.
4. AUTHORIZES amending the Sage Ranch Park Additions and adding the Cold Creek-Red Rock Connector projects to the Proposition A (Safe Neighborhood Parks Act of 1996) Workprogram.
5. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution
