RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY SUPPORTING AB 3 (BASS),  
AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 32580 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE, RELATING TO THE  
BALDWIN HILLS CONSERVANCY

WHEREAS the mission of the Baldwin Hills Conservancy (BHC) is to acquire open space and manage public lands within the Baldwin Hills area and to provide recreation, restoration and protection of wildlife habitat within the territory for the public's enjoyment and educational experience; and

WHEREAS, AB 3 (BASS) deletes the January 1, 2008 sunset date on the BHC, thereby extending the operation of the BHC indefinitely; and

WHEREAS, the staff report dated June 5, 2007 further describes the proposed legislation; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Now

*Therefore Be It Resolved*, That the Santa Monica Mountain Conservancy hereby;

1. ADOPTS the staff report dated June 5, 2007.
2. SUPPORTS AB 3 (BASS).
3. AUTHORIZES the Executive Director to communicate this support to the Resources Agency.
