RESOLUTION OF THE SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS CONSERVANCY AUTHORIZING THE  
ADDITION OF COASTAL SLOPE TRAIL PROPERTIES IN RAMIREZ, ESCONDIDO AND  
LATIGO CANYONS TO THE CONSERVANCY ACQUISITION WORKPROGRAM, MALIBU

WHEREAS, land acquisition in Ramirez, Escondido and Latigo Canyons are important to the overall integrity of the Santa Monica Mountains Zone and completion of the Coastal Slope Trail; now

*Therefore Be It Resolved*, That the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy hereby:

1. FINDS that the Coastal Slope Trail section between Ramirez and Latigo Canyons is important for a combination of ecological, recreational, viewshed, and watershed values.
2. FINDS that the proposed action is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
3. FINDS that the proposed action is consistent with the Santa Monica Mountains Comprehensive Plan.
4. ADOPTS the staff report and recommendation dated August 27, 2007.
5. AUTHORIZES adding Latigo-Ramirez Canyons Coastal Slope Trail Connector project to the Conservancy Acquisition Workprogram.
6. FURTHER AUTHORIZES the Executive Director, or his assignee, to perform any and all acts necessary to carry out this resolution
