**Brief Scope of Work (60 words maximum):**  
The City of Malibu requests funding for 2 handicap-accessible 12-passenger vans to provide public transportation services between various park and beach sites in the City of Malibu. Existing transportation services do not adequately serve the needs of visitors or park agencies in this linear community with limited public transportation opportunities.

**Funding Source Applied for:** Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy – Various

**Project Background:** The City has offered free transportation services from Westward Beach to the Point Dume Headlands Reserve since 2001. This service is daily during the summer season and on the weekends during the remainder of the year. Rider demand is very limited and the cost of service is very high at approximately \$64 per passenger trip. The City believes that it can provide a route and schedule that better serves the public by expanding the route and the number of pick-up sites.

**Project Description:** The City proposes to use one van for a regularly scheduled fixed route that could change seasonally. The fixed route would need to be clearly established so that people can rely on it to get from one park/beach site to another. The second van will be utilized to provide public access on a special needs basis throughout the year. The second van will be available for special events and unique circumstances that cannot be accommodated by existing transportation services. The City plans to work with the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy, the National Park Service, State Parks, Los Angeles County Department of Beaches and Harbors and the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District to develop a cost-effective and user-friendly service. The City plans to operate the vans year-round, but will vary the schedule based upon seasonal demand. At this time it is believed the fixed route shuttle would operate on a daily basis during the summer and only on weekends for the remainder of the year. The City will specifically work with the National Park Service ParkLINK Shuttle to ensure that there is no duplication of service.
