About the Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority: The Mountains Recreation and Conservation Authority (MRCA) is a public agency of the State of California formed in 1985 pursuant to the Joint Powers Act with the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy, the Rancho Simi Recreation and Park District, and the Conejo Recreation and Park District. It is dedicated to the preservation and management of local open space and parkland, trails and wildlife habitat. The MRCA manages and provides ranger services to over 50,000 acres of parkland that it owns and that is owned by the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy and other agencies, and provides comprehensive education and interpretation programs for the community. It is one of the key public agencies working to find innovative solutions to regional water quality and supply challenges, and to restore habitat, and create public parkland along the Los Angeles River and its tributaries.

About the Los Angeles River Center and Gardens: Owned and operated by the MRCA, the Los Angeles River Center and Gardens is located near the confluence of the Los Angeles River and the Arroyo Seco at the heart of the Cypress Park community. Formerly the Lawry's California Center, its beautiful mission-style grounds and conference facilities now serve as a neighborhood resource as well as a focal point for the renewal of the Los Angles River. Its amenities include a public park and picnic area, a visitor's center and exhibit hall, and a bicycle staging area for the several bicycle paths that converge nearby.
